Abstract

The length of the abstract should be within 150-200 words. The abstract should be formatted for A4 paper (210cm by 297cm) with 2.5cm (1 inch) margins on all four sides. Use a 14 point Times New Roman Bold font centered for the title of the abstract, a 12 point Times New Roman font either justified or left flushed for the text, a 12 point Times New Roman Italic font for keywords, a 12 point Times New Roman Bold Italic font for author names, a 12 point Times New Roman Italic font either justified or centered for author affiliations, and a 10 point Times New Roman for contact information of the corresponding author. It is preferred to have less than 5 keywords. The abstract text should be typed single spaced. Abbreviations should be spelt out in full the first time they appear and their abbreviated form included in brackets immediately after. The one-page abstract should be submitted in the form of a '.doc' (MS-WORD) document.

Please use this format for arranging your abstract in *one page* only. Such one-page-abstract will be used directly for the Proceedings.

Guidelines

Abstract title

The title should include the primary aspects of the practice or innovation, including objectives, are clearly stated in a logical progression. The topic of this abstract is relevant for the exhibition.

Abstract

A concise abstract of between 150-200 words is required. There should not be any in-text citation in the abstract. Manuscripts written in Malay must include an abstract written in English.

The abstract should include the following:

1. Brief background of the context.
2. The objective(s), are clearly stated in a logical progression. The topic is of importance and interest to the target audience.
3. The materials and methods (what were done or details of the practice) are clearly stated.
4. The usage or outcomes/findings are clearly stated. Conclusions are appropriate given the results and limitations of the practice.
5. Implications of the practice are significant.

Keywords

The author should provide a list of three to five keywords that clearly describe the subject matter of the paper, and state them after the abstract.
